## Rare Set Gilbert & Ellice Islands Banknotes

Two are listed in Pick Banknote Catalogue as not seen. The 5/- is missing from this set - it is reported that it was never issued.

Issued during WWII during the Japanese Occupation, they were emergency notes issued to pay local workers. Notes later had to be handed in to cash in for new currency. This set of 4 notes believed to be the only set that survived in private hands.

The Islands comprised of Gilbert, Ellice, Ocean, Fanning, Washington, Christmas and Phoenix, a British Colony from 1915.

The Islands were renamed Tuvalu & Kiribati and declared independent. Australian currency is now used.

Serious British Commonwealth collectors would need this set to finish their collection. This probably will be the only opportunity to do so.
